SUNDAY SCHOOL

- **Today's Lesson summary:** As we gather today, we will study "The Poolside Sign." For thirty-eight years, a paralyzed man has lain by the pool of Bethesda, hoping

to enter it and receive healing. Jesus asks if he desires healing and then tells the man to take up his bed and walk. When the Jews see the man carrying his bed on the Sabbath, they question him about who told him to do this, but the man doesn't know who Jesus is. After encountering Jesus at the temple, the man reports back to the Jewish leaders, who persecute Jesus.

- **In the youth Bible class today**, they will learn about two remarkable women who led ordinary lives and also showed extraordinary faith when clinging to Jesus, even unto death. An ancient writing titled *The Martyrdom of Perpetua and Felicitas* tells the amazing account of these two women who lived out their faith in their everyday vocations of motherhood. It is important to recognize that it was not only the leaders of the Church who suffered for the faith, but that persecution touched the lives of all Christians in the early Church. The amazing account of the martyrdom of these two women, who braved death for Jesus' sake and held tightly to the promise of the resurrection, records that "from these things many believed".
